Earth Science Regents Exam: The New York State Earth Science Regents Examination consists of the lab performance test [approximately 15%] and the written test [approximately 85%]. To be eligible to sit for both sections, you must have 1200 minutes of satisfactory laboratory reports on file.

The lab performance portion of the exam consists of three stations that is designed to evaluate various laboratory and classroom procedures refined during your yearly course of study.

The written portion of the exam consists of 50 multiple choice questions and 35 short answer questions.
